We focus on Jesus because we are convinced that He is the only one who can truly offer a fresh start at life, forgive sin, empower us for victory over our past and energize us for the life mission for which we have been created. We focus on the Bible because it alone shows the way to a restored relationship with God.*

Our church family is a multi-cultural blend of both young and old. Bible studies are offered in both Spanish and English as well, and Spanish interpretation of our Worship Service is available for those who are less familiar with the English language. Dress tends to be business-casual, but there is always a mixture of ties and blue jeans. Our 9:00 a.m. and 10:45 a.m. worship services are nearly identical, lasting sixty to seventy-five minutes. Our most common practice of preaching is to teach through a book of the Bible from beginning to end by examining the original meaning of the text with emphasis on how it applies in our lives today. Occasionally, we'll teach on a life topic from the Bible.

"Clubhouse" a **children's ministry** for infants through 5 year olds meets in the Education Building during both worship services. "Club 252" a children's ministry for Kindergarten through 5th graders meets in the Family Ministry Center during both worship services.
